Renewal 2024

The last four weeks have been a busy time for the Visioning Team. First, we published four “heads up” questions in the bulletin to get people thinking. Then came the survey, online and on paper. More than 60 surveys were returned and the information is now being tabulated. Finally, we hosted six groups for workshops to get more input on what we value and our dreams for the future. Again, more than 60 people participated and contributed lots of comments and ideas. The next step is to process all of this information and produce a summary that can be used as we move forward in our journey to renewal. A big thank you to all who participated.
